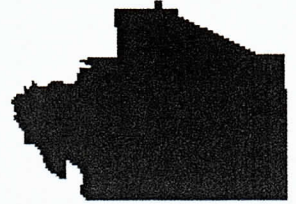

Federal & State Aide Project(s) Update

- County Road 22 Resurfacing Project needs permanent stripe and guardrail.
- County Roads 9 and 4 Resurfacing Project needs permanent stripe and guardrail.
- Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) projects due to floods:
 - CR 59 Culvert Replacement Project should be complete by end on month
 - CR 32 Bridge Replacement Project concerns which should be worked out this week and will be let on 22 Sept 2016 10:00 a.m.
 - CR 2 Grade, Drain, Base Project finishing up last details
- Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) projects due to floods
 - Small Projects \$1,173,576.50
 - Federal \$880,182.37
 - State \$146,697.06
 - Large Projects \$598,129.18
 - Federal \$448,596.88 → owed to county
 - State \$74,766.14 → owed to county
